The advanced level of training in the specialty "Law Enforcement Activity" is characterized by special attention to organizational and managerial activities in the context of regulating legal relations between the population and government bodies.

The competencies developed in students enable them to organize forensic psychological and psychological-psychiatric examinations of offenders.

During their training, students will undergo serious physical training, which will enable them to help ensure the safety of citizens using force.

The training program for secondary vocational education "Law Enforcement Activity" is implemented by the USTU College of Security and Law .

Number of seats:

40 budget places for full-time education,

50 contractual places for full-time study.
